Day of Giving is an annual fundraising movement that unites our entire community to make an impact for animals in need by supporting the lifesaving programs that will give a second chance to more than 40,000 animals this year and ensure



that San Diego County can Stay at Zero, meaning no euthanasia of healthy and treatable animals. Making Day of Giving even more special this year, more than a dozen donors are joining forces to match all donations received before 11:59 p.m. on June 30 — up to \$250,000.
