PAWS San Diego Helps Keep Pets with their Families and Out of Shelters

What: <u>PAWS San Diego</u> is hosting a community pet event at the Cesar Chavez Community Center on Saturday, Jan. 25. Families will have access to free and low-cost pet supplies and services, including vaccinations and microchipping.

> PAWS San Diego, a safety net program offered by San Diego Humane Society, helps people and pets stay together by providing essential services. PAWS San Diego offers pet food and supplies like leashes, flea medication and vouchers to assist with veterinary bills.



The community pet event is family-friendly and will include:

- Free pet supplies (available on a first come, first served basis)
- Low-cost spay/neuter appointments from <u>Animal Welfare Foundation</u> and Spay Day
- On-site spay and neuter surgeries provided by <u>Spay-Neuter Action Project (SNAP)</u>
- Free vaccinations and microchipping for dogs and cats
- Free licensing for dogs (need proof of rabies vaccination)
- Free pet behavior and training tips
