"We are there for the animals who count on us, but this year, more than ever, we need the community's help," said San Diego Humane Society Executive Vice President Brian Daugherty. "Running an animal shelter differs from a for-profit business. The shelter business model essentially operates at a deficit with each additional animal served."
