Walk for Animals — North County Canceled Due to Rain

ESCONDIDO, CA — San Diego Humane Society’s 24th annual Walk for Animals — North County this Saturday, Feb. 25, 2023 at Kit Carson Park in Escondido has been canceled due to the weather. Rain and windy conditions leading up to the walk and on Saturday morning will make conditions unsafe for the event.

The Walk is one of San Diego Humane Society’s most important fundraising events of the year, and plays a key role in the organization’s ability to care for more than 40,000 pets and wildlife each year. While the physical walk is canceled, registered participants are encouraged to continue fundraising for the animals.
